**PROOF OF PAYMENT REQUIRED**

The South African Board for Sheriffs have implemented a new accounting standard applicable to the Public Sector. The General Recognised Accounting Practice (GRAP) requires the Board to make use of the accrual accounting system with the major change being the implementation of Accounts receivable as part of our accounting system.

We have captured all the information and are ready to send out statements and invoices to all Sheriffs. We, however, have certain challenges around monies paid to the Board and the Fidelity Fund. It's not always clear as to who made the deposit and we are therefore not able to allocate the deposits correctly.

We would like to provide you with accurate statements and invoices and therefore, we request all Sheriffs to submit as soon as possible, all proof of payments for the period 1 May 2013 to 30 April 2014 (Legal obligations 2013, Fidelity Fund applications, new appointments, Deputy Sheriff appointments, etc). We are aware that many Sheriffs have submitted their required proof of payment, but we would urge you to re-submit your proof of payment to the Board by no later than, Friday, 18 July 2014.
